
#### **Humanistic Presuppositions:**

- The world is only physical and can only be understood through naturalistic and material methods.
- Absolute truth does not exist. Such claims are individual and cultural, usually a strategy imposed upon the weak-minded by those who wish to oppress others.

## **Ending Where You Begin**

#### The Theistic Presupposition:

- The Bible is a record of God's intimate and effective engagement in history with man.
- The Bible carries many human characteristics of the human culture in which it was written, but its chief meaning, purpose, and application must be understood as inspired by the mind, will, and heart of God.



#### **Incarnation and Inspiration**

The incarnation of God's living Word:

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God." (John 1:1-2)

"The Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw his glory." (John 1:14)

#### **Incarnation and Inspiration**

The inspiration of God's written Word:

"All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work." (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

#### **Incarnation and Inspiration**

Just as Jesus—the incarnate Word of God—was simultaneously fully God and fully man, so is the Bible—the written Word of God—fully divine and fully human.

#### Through incarnation and inspiration:

- The divine is unified with the human;
- The transcendent with the rational;
- The world of faith with the world of evidence.

## "Breathed out by God": Theopneustos

"Theopneustos does not denote 'inspiring' or 'inspiration,' but rather 'spiring' or 'spiration.' This implies that the Scripture is not a human product of what was 'breathed into' the human writers by God..."

In this way, men carried along by the Holy Spirit indicates that they could communicate God's words in a way that was common to their own understanding and background.

Hence, the variation of styles by the individual writer, but importantly...a common divine source.


#### **Incarnation and Inspiration**
