The Capstone of Creation

"Saturday" in Spanish = "Sabado"

A Sign of God's Covenant

"Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates." (Exodus 20:8-11)

A Sign of God's Covenant

"For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy." (Exodus 20:8-11)

A Sign of God's Covenant

"You shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the LORD your God brought you out from there with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm. Therefore the LORD your God commanded you to keep the Sabbath day."

(Deuteronomy 5:12-15)

Should Christians Observe the Sabbath?

The Ten Commandments:

- You shall have no other gods before me. (Ex. 20:3)
- Remember the Sabbath day. (Ex. 20:8-11)
- Honor your father and mother. (Ex. 20:12)
- You shall not commit murder. (Ex. 20:13)
- You shall not commit adultery. (Ex. 20:14)



Periods of time or seasons in Scripture are most often connected to God's provision and his rule over creation.






Following the Rhythms of God's Creation

- Remember the Sabbath day. (Ex. 20:8-11)


"The LORD is my shepherd. I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul."
