Did Jesus Honor the Sabbath?



Did Jesus Honor the Sabbath?






Lord of the Sabbath



"Behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a Son Of Man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him."



The Sabbath Rest of a New Creation



(Ephesians 2:8-10)


The Sabbath Rest of a New Creation


