




I have surely seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt and have heard their cry...I know their sufferings, and I have come down to deliver them...

#### **A Transcendent Intimacy**

Scripture is abundant with detail about a God who, despite his holiness and transcendence, has entered into the created world as intimately as one could imagine.

#### **A Transcendent Intimacy**

The heart-cry of one of God's prophets echoes our own cry:

"Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains might quake at your presence...

For from days of old they have not heard or perceived by ear, nor has the eye seen a God besides you, who acts in behalf of the one who waits for Him." (Isaiah 64:1, 4)

#### **A Transcendent Intimacy**

While transcendent and supreme, God created the world through intimate connection:

- Speaking his creation into being. (Genesis 1:3-26)
- Bonding with mankind in creating us in his own image. (Genesis 1:26)
- Commanding man to pursue the life-giving fruit that only intimacy can produce. (Genesis 1:28)

#### **A Transcendent Intimacy**

While transcendent and supreme, God created the world through intimate connection:

- God lowered himself to touch the dirty soil and form man from the dust of the ground. (Genesis 2:7)
- God intimately breathed into man the breath of life. (Genesis 2:7)
- God walked in earthly gardens in the cool of the day. (Genesis 3:8)

"I am with you and will keep you wherever you go...For I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you." (Genesis 28:15)


#### **A Transcendent Intimacy**




















#### In Whom We Live, and Move, & Have Our Being
