


"Ultimately, at the heart of the proclamation of the truth is love. And a life of love is the embodiment of the truth.


Truth Without Love...Love Without Truth

The True Love of God

Most laws (or commandments) exist for our benefit. Their purpose is in this sense—loving:

- A stop sign—A Social Law for our benefit.
- Gravity—A *Physical* Law it would benefit us not to compromise near a cliff.
- God's Word—A Spiritual Law we can follow for our benefit.

The True Love of God
