What Is Truth?


For Pilate, there would be no answer. There was no need to answer...






Which is the most fundamental question?

"God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?" (Numbers 23:19)

"The works of his hands are truth and justice; All his precepts are sure. They are upheld forever and ever; They are performed in truth and uprightness." (Psalm 111:7-8)

"I the LORD do not change." (Malachi 3:6)

"I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land. For I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you." (Genesis 28:15)

True Relationship

"Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world. And for their sake I consecrate myself, that they also may be sanctified in truth. I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me." (John 17:17-21)
