


# Life Is Relationship

Often without our awareness, our human ways of viewing the world can keep us from truly belonging to him in the way God intends.




Everything Personal

Freedom in Relationship


Only by surrendering our freedom to the governance of God in relationship can we ever truly know what it means to be free.

### **Living In Absolute Relationship**

The objective of most Christian apologists is to defend absolute truth.

Absolute: "Universal, perfect, pervasive, allaffecting. Not relative, variable, or subjective."

But the fundamental way to believe in the life of Christianity—and to call others to believe—is to live our lives in absolute relationship with God & others.
