





"This is what I give. I give an expression of care every day to each child, to help him realize that he is unique. I end the program by saying, 'You've made this day a special day, by just your being you."



- Offers us a higher perspective on others—no matter their present circumstances—that they are still precious and worth celebrating.
- Gives us hope for their future and who they can become.

The Power of Thanksgiving

Thanking GOD for others...

 Allows us to believe in and encourage others in a way we could never accomplish within our own power.



Paul's Thankfulness

"I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is proclaimed in all the world. For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I mention you always in my prayers, asking that somehow by God's will I may now at last succeed in coming to you." (Romans 1:8-10)

Paul's Thankfulness

"Because I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love toward all the saints, I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him..." (Ephesians 1:15-17)

Paul's Thankfulness

"We give thanks to God always for all of you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers, remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ."

(1 Thessalonians 1:2-3)

"Paul's thanksgivings generally follow the same pattern:

- 1. Give thanks...
- 2. to God...
- 3. Always...
- 4. for the recipients...
- 5. For certain reasons, which are then elaborated..."

Paul's Focus of Thankfulness

Paul's thankfulness had an absolute GOD focus:

"God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord." (1 Corinthians 1:9)

Paul's Focus of Thankfulness

"If Paul's confidence lay in the Corinthians themselves, then he is in trouble.

But...in Paul's theology the *indicative* (God's prior action of grace) always precedes the *imperative* (their obedience as response to grace) and is the ground of his confidence."

— Gordon Fee

Paul's Focus of Thankfulness

"Even though Paul is concerned to remind the church that they have not yet arrived, at the same time he holds out before them his great confidence that by God's own action they will indeed make it in the end."

— Gordon Fee


Paul's Focus of Thankfulness

"Consequently, by means of thanksgiving Paul redirects their confidence from themselves and their own giftedness toward the eternal God, from whom and to whom are all things."

Paul's Focus of Thankfulness

"I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now. And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. It is right for me to feel this way about you all, because I hold you in my heart." (Philippians 1:3-7)
